Dear Partners, Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

our surface protection was developed as part of a research project with the EU and the federal government in 2017 against multi-resistant germs (MRSA) in hospitals. In mid-2019 we were finished and started the registration process. Then came Corona.

We have subjected our surface protection to many stress tests, test runs and extensive certifications in the past few months. We currently have the following certifications:

1. ISO 22196: 2011 - independent institute MTC: confirmation of the antibacterial properties
2. ISO 21702: 2019 - independent institute Eurovir: confirmation of the antiviral properties
3. Dermatest: dermatological harmlessness
4. Test certificate EN 71-3: confirmation for non-toxic surfaces, even for children's toys

With the growing demand and successful implementation of THAT’S IT, we have started a second certification phase in cooperation with other experts and institutes. Here are the following points:

1. *Revised CE declaration as a manufacturer's mark (**already finished**)*
2. *Further long-term evidence in cooperation with the Institute Fresenius (accredited)*
3. *Further virus checks / lab reports in cooperation with Institute Fresenius (accredited)*
4. *International certifications in cooperation with SGS*
5. *ISO 9001*
6. *Supplier evaluations*
7. *Virus equivalence tests*
8. *TÜV certification*
9. *Report for the risk assessment according to ArbSchG and BioStoffV (German law, occupational health, and safety law) for the handling of THAT’S IT products*
10. *Operating instruction for all THAT’S IT products*



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Our R&D team is every day busy with the tasks and improvement for our certification. To support you and to support the expansion world-wide. Here it is important to know, that our product is an innovation which can not fit into the old / traditional way of disinfection. For example: in the USA, the EPA is searching especially for such “long lasting disinfectants”. There will follow a new categorization and new standards will apply. In Germany we can not fit into the “pattern” of the Robert-Koch Institute (RKI) to be compared as a surface disinfection. The definition of disinfection is changed through our innovation and product.

This means that we work also “lobbyistcly” in every possible area of validation and standard developing structure in Germany. The goal is to bring our new way of surface protection into the right patterns, compare it with the old-fashioned way of disinfection and set the right rules and standards. We did the first step to climb the ladder already over the last 9 months. Now with the second certification phase we will get much closer to our goal – also in a leading position through many other experts in our team.

In the end we have compare different worlds: medical / technical documentation, industrial safety & labor protection, virology, and industrial standards.

We are on a good way and we are looking forward to improving our quality every day.
